



Clinic Program

The clinic program at The Riley Center provides individual behavioral therapy based on the principles of applied behavioral analysis (ABA) for children diagnosed with autism. The ABA approach includes specialized instruction in the areas of communication, behavior, cognition, daily living and social and play skills. It is the only proven method used to treat autism.

In addition to ABA therapy, the center also provides the following services:

- **Diagnostic Services** – A diagnostic clinic consisting of a multidisciplinary team is available for children suspected with Autism Spectrum Disorder.
- **Occupational Therapy / Sensory Training** - Individual sessions available.
- **Speech and Language Services** – Individual sessions available.
- **Parent Support Meetings** – Provides information on issues concerning autism.
- **Monthly Parent and Caregiver Training Clinics** – The center's board certified behavior analyst holds monthly training clinics for parents and caregivers. An overview of children's current programs is discussed as well as training on how to generalize these skills.
